WRR to broadcast Ginastera Concert 9 p.m. June 16

WRR will broadcast the 30th anniversary performance of Ginastera's Third String Quartet on Wednesday, June 16 at 9 p.m. The music, commissioned by the Dallas Chamber Music Society and the Dallas Public Library, premiered in Dallas in 1974. The work was dedicated to John Rosenfield, a Dallas Morning News arts critic who died in 1966.

WRR and the Dallas Public Library presented the 30th anniversary performance of this quartet at the library's Lillian Bradshaw Gallery on May 30. The concert performed by the highly regarded Adkins String Ensemble and soprano Lucy Tamez Creech, a Dallas favorite, received rave reviews from the audience and *The Dallas Morning News*.

In his June 1 review, Olin Chism wrote, "Sunday afternoon's performance was gripping and close to awe-inspiring."

The broadcast will include comments from 98-year-old Dorothea Kelley, who was instrumental in the selection of the composer and the commission of the work. Joseph Klein, of the College of Music at the University of North Texas, conducted.

The Third String Quartet is a unique encounter between two 20th century movements in companion art forms: surrealism in literature and serialism in music. The quartet is in five movements, four of which include a vocal part. The work also includes poems by Juan Ramon Jimenez, Garcia Lorca and Rafael Alberti.
