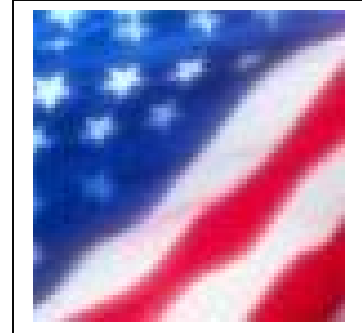

Dallas Booms July 3 at Dallas City Hall Plaza

WRR kicks off the holiday weekend Sunday, July 3 at Dallas Booms with Target® 3D Fireworks presented by Target Corporation and the City of Dallas at City Hall Plaza in downtown Dallas.

The evening will include fireworks and a patriotic concert featuring the Dallas Symphony Orchestra. WRR will broadcast the event live, and Target will provide the biggest fireworks display in North Texas. Access to the concert area at 1500 Marilla begins at 6 p.m.; the free concert begins at approximately 8:30 p.m. with synchronized fireworks accompanying the symphony performance finale at approximately 9:30 p.m.

Dallas Wind Symphony's Star-Spangled Spectacular

On July 4, WRR will sponsor the Dallas Wind Symphony's *A Star-Spangled Spectacular* at the Meyerson Symphony Center. Concerts are at 1 p.m. and 4 p.m. It's the Wind Symphony's annual toe-tapping, flag-waving tribute to Mom, apple pie and Old Glory. The concert includes hot dogs, homemade ice cream, a red, white and blue costume contest, indoor fireworks, an 11-foot tall Uncle Sam and a special salute to World War II veterans. Colonel Arnard D. Gabriel, Conductor Emeritus of the U.S. Air Force Band, will conduct. For tickets, call 214-528-5576. WRR will rebroadcast the DWS concert at 9 p.m. on July 4.

Old-Fashioned Fourth at Old City Park

This year's best bet for a grand Fourth of July daytime family outing is the 29th Annual *Old-Fashioned Fourth at Old City Park* on Monday, July 4, from 11 a.m. – 4 p.m. A very special feature at this year's Old City Park event will be a citizenship ceremony with more than 50 people being sworn in as the

newest U.S. citizens. The ceremony will be following a flag-waving patriotic program at noon, with a reading of the Declaration of Independence & Pledge of Allegiance. All activities highlight a Texas Fourth as it might have been celebrated during pioneer and Victorian days.

General admission is \$7 at the gate. Advance discount tickets are available online at \$6 for at www.oldcitypark.org. Members of Old City Park get in free and children under four years old are admitted free.

Parking is free around the Old City Park grounds, and at the First Presbyterian Church of Dallas parking garage at the northwest corner of Harwood and Young Streets. A free shuttle will operate continuously from First Presbyterian. Old City Park is located at 1717 Gano, between Harwood and Ervay Streets, one block south of I-30 and the Farmer's Market.
